CAPIC Rodeo 11 Contest Rules

This contest is open to all post-secondary visual arts students.

There is a maximum of 26 entries accepted for this contest from all submitted entries.

“Acceptance” constitutes “winning”

One “entry” consists of a single image.

Students can enter as many times as they like but are limited to a maximum of three “wins” per member.

There are six cash prizes in total: First, Second, & Third for Photography, and First, Second, & Third for Illustration.

All students who enter will receive a free one-year Student CAPIC membership.

Top 10 finalists in each category receive a free one-year Emerging Talent CAPIC Membership.

Judging Criteria

Images will be rated by a number-based scoring system. A maximum of 26 images with the highest ratings overall will be considered winners.

Only digital image files will be accepted for judging. Please format your image as a JPEG file, the longest dimension being 1000 pixels at 72 dpi.

An entry fee of \$20 (plus GST/HST) will be charged for each entry.

Winners will be notified by email. The final artwork must be submitted in uncompressed tiff format to the CAPIC National Office. Winners will receive specific instructions via email on how to upload.

CAPIC Rodeo 11 Contest

The Rodeo contest is a private contest, conducted by CAPIC. By submitting an entry, you agree that all decisions made by the judges and by the Rodeo 11 contest committee respecting the entry are final and irrevocable. Copyright of all works entered in the Rodeo 11 contest remains with the creator(s).

License: By submitting your work(s) to the Rodeo 11 contest you grant a non-exclusive license to CAPIC to reproduce the accepted entries in contest publicity material for both 2019 & 2020 (including the CAPIC website) and to hang the work during the aforementioned time period.
