



## CAPIC Rodeo 16 Contest Rules

Rodeo is an annual student photography and illustration competition held by the Canadian Association of Professional Image Creators (CAPIC)! The contest is open to all post-secondary visual arts students across Canada. Students may submit images in either of the two categories: photography or illustration. The top 3 winners in each category will win cash prizes and gain national exposure!

Students may enter up to a maximum of 20 images. All students who enter will receive a free one-year Student CAPIC membership. A panel of industry professionals will judge all entries to CAPIC Rodeo 16. **Please submit your entries in JPEG format, the longest dimension being 1000 pixels at 72 dpi.**

**An entry fee of \$20 (plus applicable taxes) will be charged for each entry.**

**Fine Print:** Rodeo 16 is a private contest conducted by CAPIC. By submitting an entry, you agree that all decisions made by the judges and by the Rodeo 16 contest committee are final and irrevocable. You agree to indemnify the 2024 Rodeo contest judges, the Rodeo 16 contest committee, and CAPIC against any and all damages arising out of your submitting work to this contest.

**Declaration of Copyright Ownership:** You certify that all necessary licenses and/or releases affecting all components of subjects of the work entered in the Rodeo 16 contest have been obtained and that the entrant is the creator of the image entered. In works with joint creators, the submitting creator certifies that the permission of the other creator(s) has been obtained and that proof of that agreement will be supplied if requested by the Rodeo 16 contest committee. Copyright of all works entered in the Rodeo 16 contest remains with the creator(s).

**License:** By submitting your work(s) to the Rodeo 16 contest you grant a non-exclusive license to CAPIC to reproduce the accepted entries publicly for both 2024 and 2025 (including on the CAPIC website).
